AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE BURNING OF BUILDINGS, STRUCTURES, AND TRASH IN THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND REVOKING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS.

I

The burning of trash in trash barrels or containers within the city limits is prohibited, except that burning is allowed between the hours of 6:00 o'clock a.m. and 9:00 o'clock a.m. of each day.

II

There shall be no burning of buildings or other structures without the written permission of the Fire Chief of the City of Sedan, Kansas, and the Fire Chief is specifically authorized to impose the conditions of burning, if written permission is given.

III

Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon the conviction thereof, shall be fined in a sum of not more than \$1,000.00.

IV

All provisions of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance be and they are hereby repealed insofar as they apply to this ordinance.

V

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its publication in the official city newspaper, the Sedan Times Star.
