

ORDINANCE NO. 848

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING HORSES, CATTLE, SHEEP, GOATS AND LLAMAS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF SEDAN, KANSAS.

Section 1. Any person who shall within the City of Sedan, Kansas, harbor or keep horses, cattle, sheep, goats and llamas shall comply with the following requirements:


- a. There shall be a minimum of 200 sq. feet per animal fenced or penned at least 25 feet away from the property line of the party harboring or keeping said animal or animals.
- b. All such pens or areas fenced for said livestock shall be at least 50 feet from any residence, including the residence of the party harboring or keeping said livestock on their property.
- c. The person harboring or keeping said livestock must maintain a grass cover within the fenced in or penned area, and waste from the animals must be disposed of and removed from the property.
- d. There shall be appropriate fly and insect control in harboring or keeping said animals.


Section 2. This Ordinance does not cover fowl, pigs, dogs or cats, which are dealt with in other ordinances of the City of Sedan.

Section 3. A person convicted of a violation of this ordinance may be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$500.00.

This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its publication one (1) time in the Sedan Times Star.
