ORDINANCE NO. 886

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO APPLICATION FOR CAMPING LICENSES ON CITY OWNED PROPERTY

Now therefore, be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Sedan, Kansas:

Section 1.

License Required:

It shall be unlawful for any person to camp in any city park or upon any city lake property owned by the city without first obtaining a license from the City Clerk. For purposes of this ordinance, the word "camp" shall mean to establish and/or set up an area in which to stay or sleep overnight for one or more nights.

Section 2.

Application Process:

Upon submitting an application on a form proscribed by the city, and payment of a daily camping fee of \$10.00, the City Clerk shall issue any person making such application and paying such fee a camping license permitting such person to camp in a city park or upon a city lake property owned by the city.

Section 3.

Penalty:

Any violation of this ordinance is a Class C misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not less than \$200.00 nor more than \$500.00 and/or confinement in jail not to exceed one month, or both such fine and jail sentence.

Section 4.

Repeal of Previous Ordinances:

Ordinances number 740 and 758, and all other ordinances inconsistent with this ordinance, are hereby repealed.

Section 5.

Effective Date:

This ordinance shall take effect upon its publication in the official city newspaper.
